Preschool Policies

- Any adult placing a child in the Preschool must be attending an on-campus event unless otherwise cleared through the Children's Ministry.
- Label diaper bags, clothing, and other personal items with child's full name.
 Please include a change of clothing.
- Only disposable diapers are allowed in the nursery.
- Personal toys should be left at home.
- Please advise teachers & PCM staff of any allergies or special conditions.
- Medication will not be administered to any child.
- At check-in you will receive a security tag, and you will be asked to provide your cell phone number

in the event we need to reach you.

If you wish to check on your child during a session, please check with the supervisor at the Preschool Welcome Desk.



- Your security tag must be presented at pickup. Preschoolers will not be released to minors younger than high school, including siblings, even when the security tag is presented.
- To avoid congestion in the hallways, please ask family members to wait in the main fover during drop-off and pickup.
- In the event of a minor scrape or bump, first aid will be administered and parents will be informed at the end of the session. In case of a more serious accident, parents will be notified immediately. For any lifethreatening emergency, 911 will be called.
- If a child contracts a childhood disease following a session in the Preschool, the Children's Minister should be notified.
- In accordance with the recommendations from the Committee on Control of Infectious Diseases of the American Academy of Pediatrics, we cannot accept any child with symptoms such as:

- Fever of 100 or greater
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Any symptom of communicable childhood diseases, i.e. Scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chicken pox
- Sore throat
- Croup, persistent cough
- Any unexplained rash
- Any skin infection, i.e. boils, ringworm, impetigo
- Pink eye and other eye infection
- Runny nose showing signs of infection

Children should be free of fever and illness for 24 hours before being left. Children who appear ill while in the Preschool will be isolated, and the parents will be called to pick up the child.

Any questions or concerns should be directed to the supervisor on duty or the Children's Minister.
